The Association of Mink and Somers, our volunteer social

organization on the lakes.

The MSLID, Mink Somers Lake Improvement District is working this year on our core mission "improve the water quality to enhance the use and enjoyment of the lakes." We have completed spraying our traditional boating channels for curly leaf pondweed and we have an ongoing assessment and plan for managing Eurasian Milfoil. Also we have a number of Board members monitoring for zebra mussels; as of now this aquatic invasive species (AIS) has not been found on our lake.

One of the major project we will be studying is the phosphorous that contributes to the algae growth particularly in the late summer. Although there is a lot of phosphorous already in the lake, sediment run off from our properties and the inlet on Mink Lake are contributing to lower water clarity. RMB Environmental Laboratories measures our water samples and a major trend report is due out this month. Buffer strips and retention and filtration systems have been shown to reduce phosphorous by over 50%; that contribute substantially to our water clarity. We are studying these options and will report back to our property owners with the how we might move forward in our

mission to "protect the lakes". My thanks to all our Board Members!
