Eurasian Water Milfoil (EWM) was discovered in Somers Lake the summer of 2013.

The Mink Somers LID Board has voted to aggressively attempt to control EWM now found in both lakes by engaging Clarke Environmental Services to apply spot treatment of chemicals to the areas identified with colonies of EWM.

Your help is needed to insure the EWM does not become an overwhelming issue on our lakes.... And in particular in front of your property.

The DNR requires your signature authorizing treatment of EWM discovered in front of your property from shore out to 150 feet. The treatment is funded by LID, with possible financial assistance from the several government sources, both state and county.

You will be contacted with a request for authorization to chemically treat any EWM found in front of your property from shore to 150 feet out. This will happen between April and June.

Spraying for EWM will be done separately from the spraying for Curley Leaf Pondweed and individual shoreline Vegetation spraying.
