Carp Gate / Outlet

Greg shared the story about putting down the carp gate in late April when the water was high and flowing fast. It got clogged with debris and wouldn't come back up. We had to pull it out with a truck and chains.

A temporary fence was installed at the outlet. Home owner Steve Compton was in attendance and shared his observations of carp swimming up the creek and getting through the temporary fence.

Another fence was installed about 20 yards from the lake. Due to the heavy outlet flow, the water has washed out some of the earth that was put in place in 2021. The LID will have to address this and a more permanent carp gate in the future.

Aeration equipment gathering

Doug and Steve haven't been able to gather the aerators and signs yet because their boats are not in the water yet. They will get to it as soon as possible

Channel spraying: channel spraying was done on Thursday, 5/18 by Limnopro

Curly leaf pond week spraying: Dylan has been in contact with Doug from Limnopro and Solitude. No update on timing.

Cattails near the boat landing: Audrey from the DNR responded saying the DNR will not be doing any cattail removing. She would however, approve a permit for us to control. We agreed that we should apply for a permit to do so.

Future of the LID: Doug voiced his concern about the lack of willing members for the LID and proposed that the LID merge with TAMS. He is crafting a draft letter to the home owners of the current situation to be reviewed by the LID and TAMS

Ecoli testing: we agreed that E coli testing of water from the bird farm culvert by the county should continue this year.
